A type of shot where the player winds up and "slaps" at the puck




#### **EXPECTED GOALS**

The spot he takes his slapshot from most often




#### **OVECHKIN**



- Alexander "Ovi" Ovechkin
  - Currently 38 years old
- Regarded as one of the greatest goal scorers of all time
  - Drafted first overall in 2004
  - Currently has **853 career goals**

#### **GRETZKY**



- Wayne Gretzky, AKA "The Great One"
  - Was 38 when he retired
- Unanimously considered the greatest player of all time
  - Undrafted, 'rookie' year in 1979
- Holds the NHL record at **894 career**

#### THINGS TO CONSIDER

- Age
  - o 38 years old
  - Average NHLer retires in their 30s
- Contract
  - Two years left on his contract
- Declining production
  - Most seasons ~ 0.60 goals per game (GPG)
  - Last year he averaged 0.39 GPG his career lowest
  - o His main skill is still really good .





#### **GP PER YEAR**











ZoneShotPrediction\*ZoneShooting% = xGoalsinZone












#### **OVECHKIN VS GRETZKY**







#### P(X > 41) =

2026 from our previous regression model, we created a normal distribution of the two predictions added to calculate the probability that Ovechkin scores more than 41 goals.

We also factored in the probability that there is a shortened season, which given that there have only even been 5 shortened seasons, still predicted a probability of 0.963 that he reaches 41 goals.

## CONCLUSIO

No matter what way you look at it, whether you wan to ay Ovechkin isn't producing as much as he used to, it is entirely probable and very likely that in 2 years or less, we will have a new NHL goal record holder.
